Old Testament

- Pentateuch = 5 scrolls (Torah = Law/Teaching)
- Histories
- Prophets. God's spokesmen
- Poetry collections sacred and secular!
- Popular religious philosophy



Old Testament

- The Jewish Scriptures
- The Bible of Jesus and early Church
- A collection of books
- Many literary types
- Mainly unknown authors/editors
- Timespan of 1,000 years +



New Testament

- Four Gospels interpretations of Jesus' death, resurrection and its significance. Unique
- Only Luke/Acts claims to be "historian"
- The Letters not consciously written as Scripture
- Apostle Paul penned 25% + of NT
- Revelation Apocalyptic. Earthly encouragement from future/heavenly hopes



<u>New Testament – Timescales</u>

- Paul's Letters. 50 AD to 65 AD
- Gospels. 60 AD to 100 AD
- Revelation. 85/95 AD?

By end of 1st century/early 2nd century –

> All our NT books in general church circulation



Formation of Canon of Scripture

<u>Canon</u>

- Reed/Rod.....ruler/yardstick
- Criteria for inclusion/exclusion
- Authoritative collection of God's Revelation



Old Testament Canon

<u>Criteria</u>

- 1. Written by/closely associated with, prophets/great leaders?
- 2. Authenticated by mighty acts of God?
- 3. Inspired by God's Spirit?

"Men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit." 2 Pet. 1:20-21.



New Testament Canon

- Apostolic authorship or associations?
- "The ring of truth"? Ultimately by inspiration of God?
- Regularly read and used in churches? Early Church Fathers' endorsement?

Late second century AD

- > Most of our NT books recognised as Scripture
- Not 4th century!



Reliability

- Accurate oral tradition
- Links with eyewitnesses and Apostles
- Many ancient copies largely accurate textual transmission
- Scribe a skilled and respected profession
- Archaeology illuminates background does not/cannot prove the Bible true

- God's self-revelation in Christ
