Apologetics v. Evangelism - The Difference?

EVANGELISM

"Umbrella" word for sharing/proclaiming the Gospel

APOLOGETICS

Presenting the case for Faith - prepares the ground for evangelism

LESSONS (1)

- Understand worldview and culture
- Start from current beliefs/outlook and build up the case for faith
- Apologetics has Practical and Intellectual objectives
- Confronting false ideas with the truth
- Provoking interest and desire to know more. Keep communication open
- Evangelistic aspect. Persuading and encouraging to believe

LESSONS (2)

- Truth matters but so do tone and method of presentation!
