When the Lord saw her, He felt compassion for her, and said to her, "Do not weep."

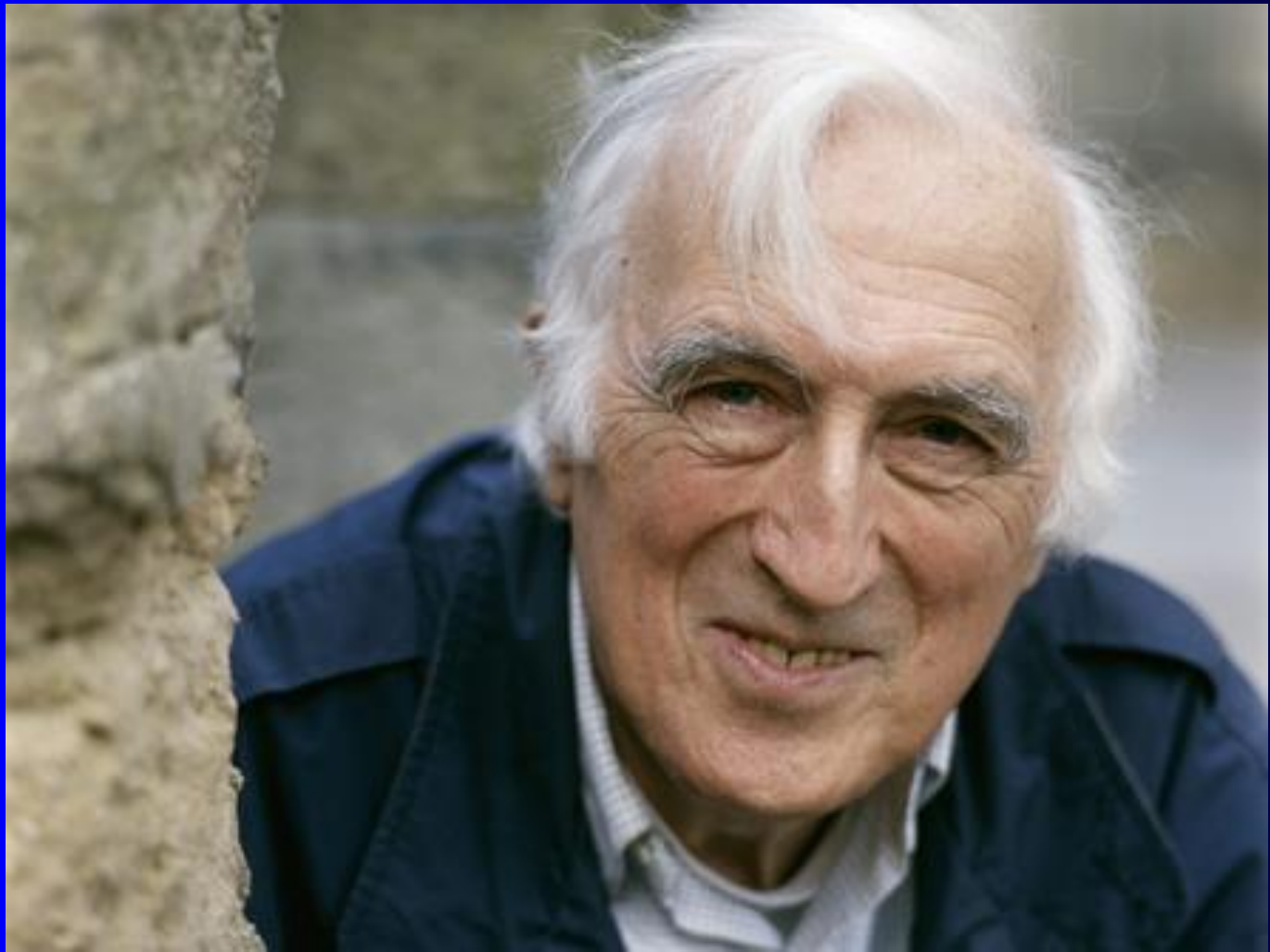

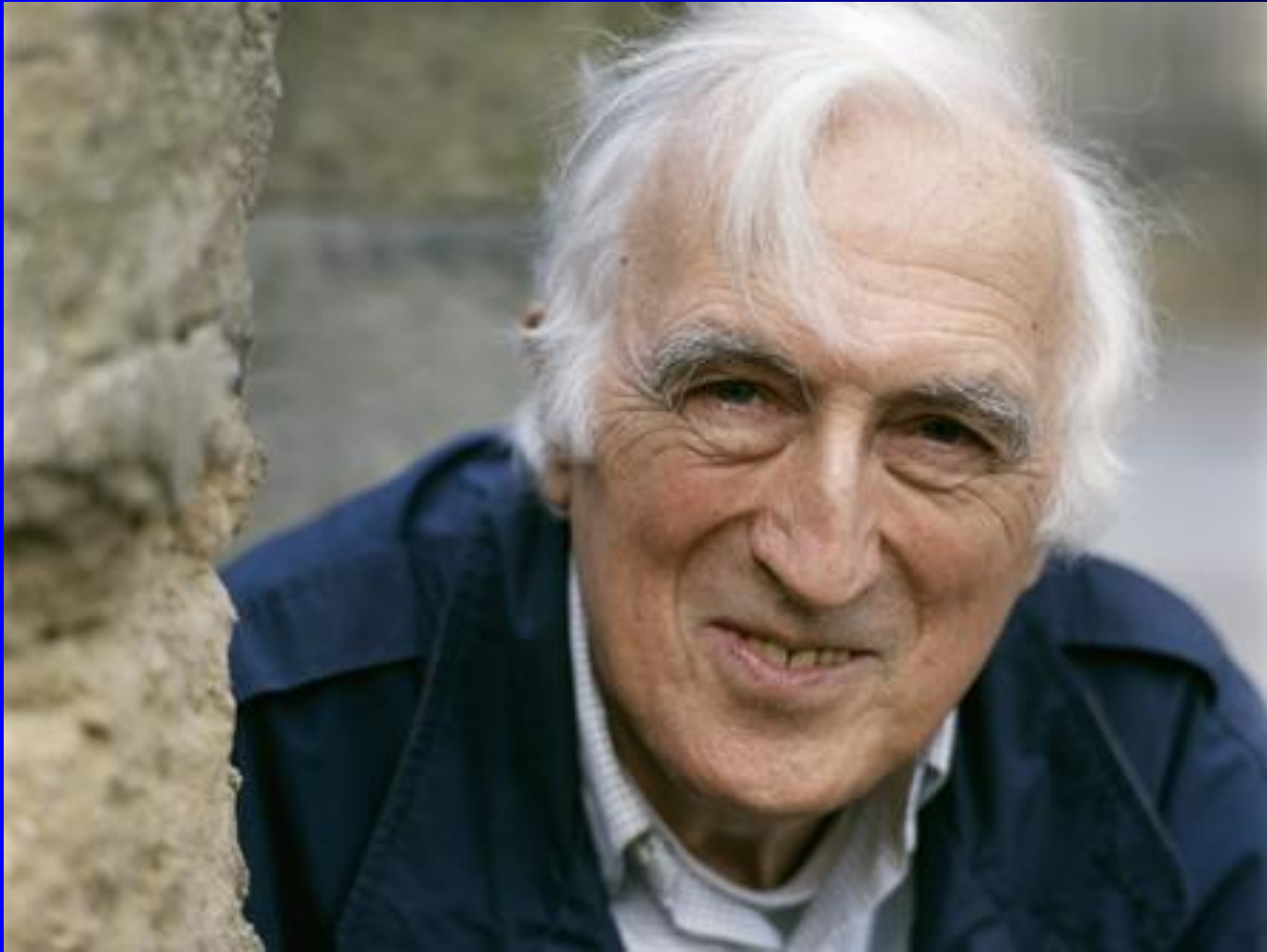
