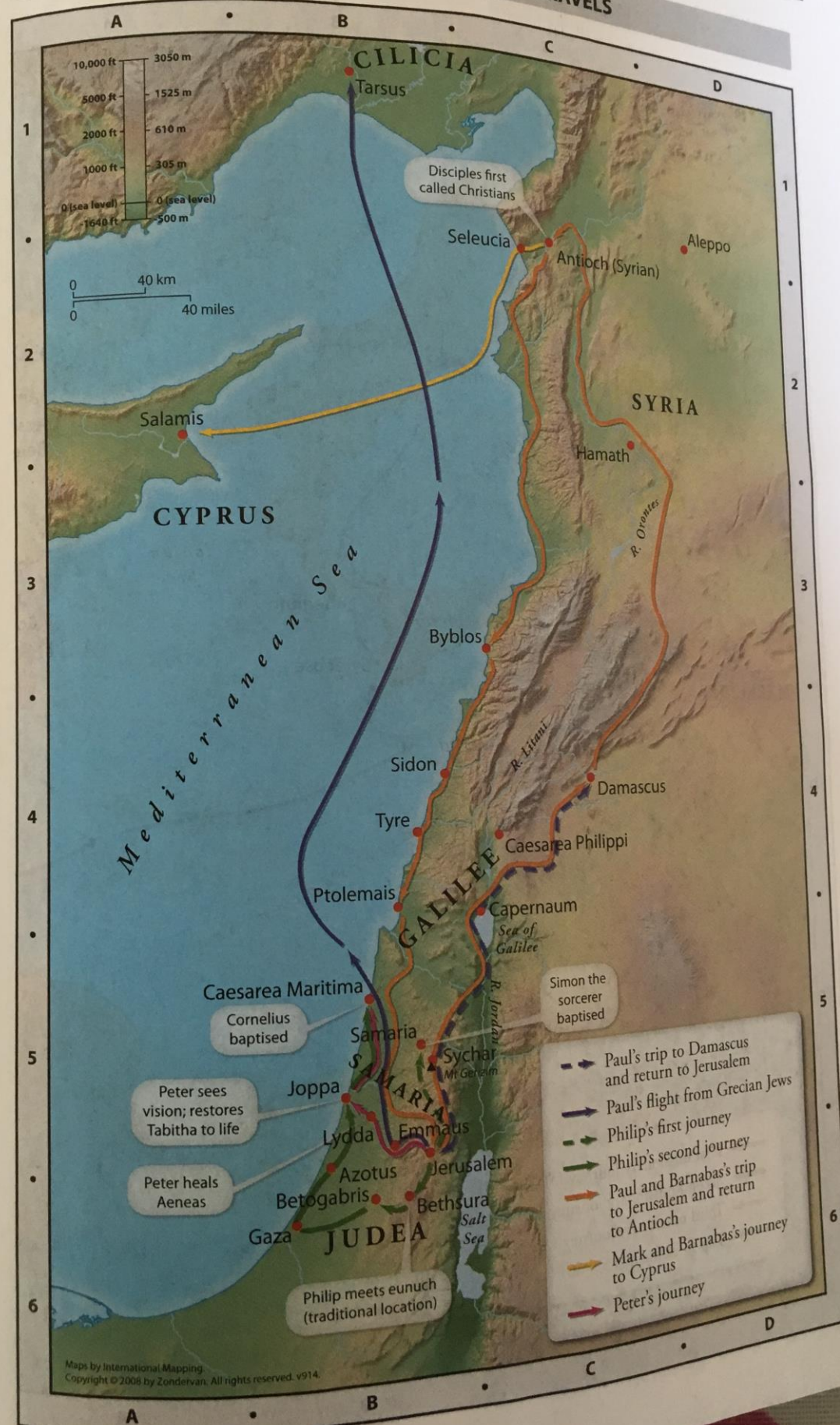


Map 12: APOSTLES' EARLY TRAVELS

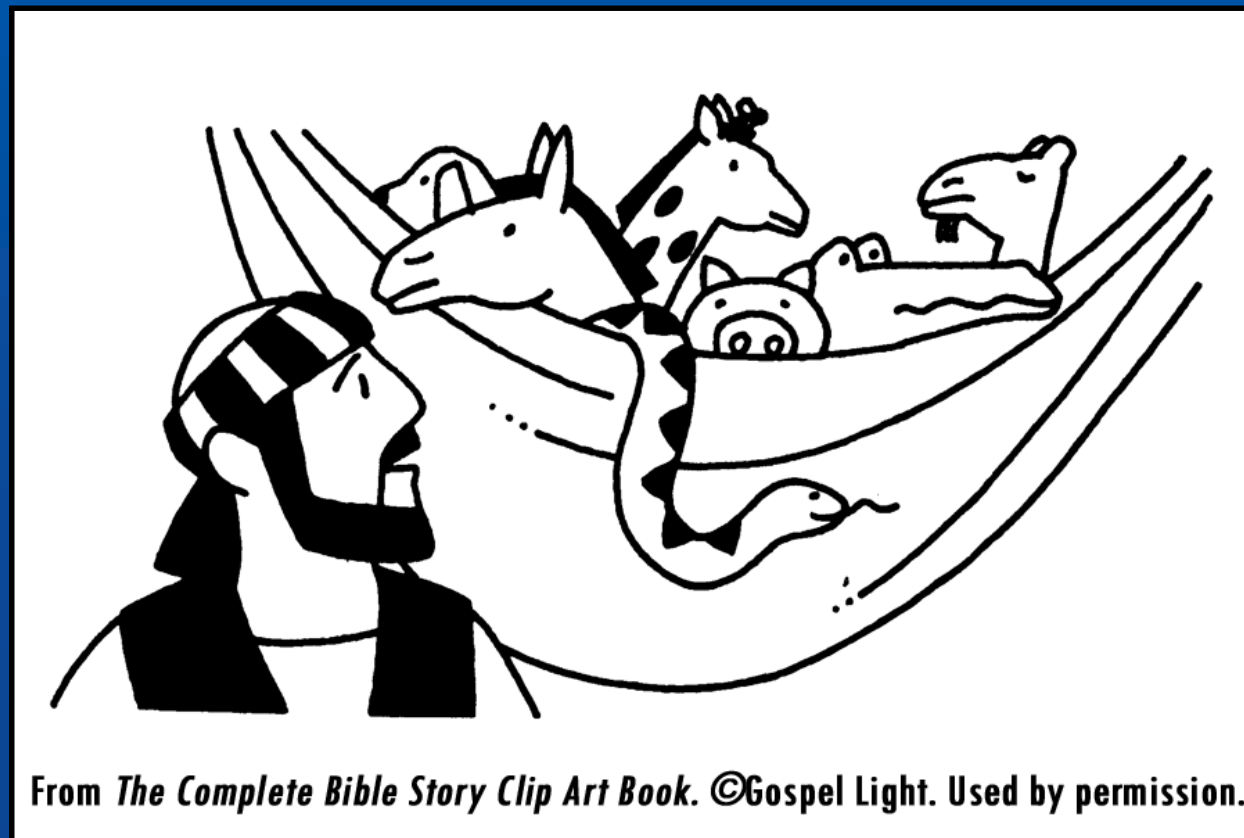




The harbour at Caesarea Maritima. Caesarea was the headquarters for the Roman forces, and Cornelius was stationed there as a centurion (Acts 10:1).

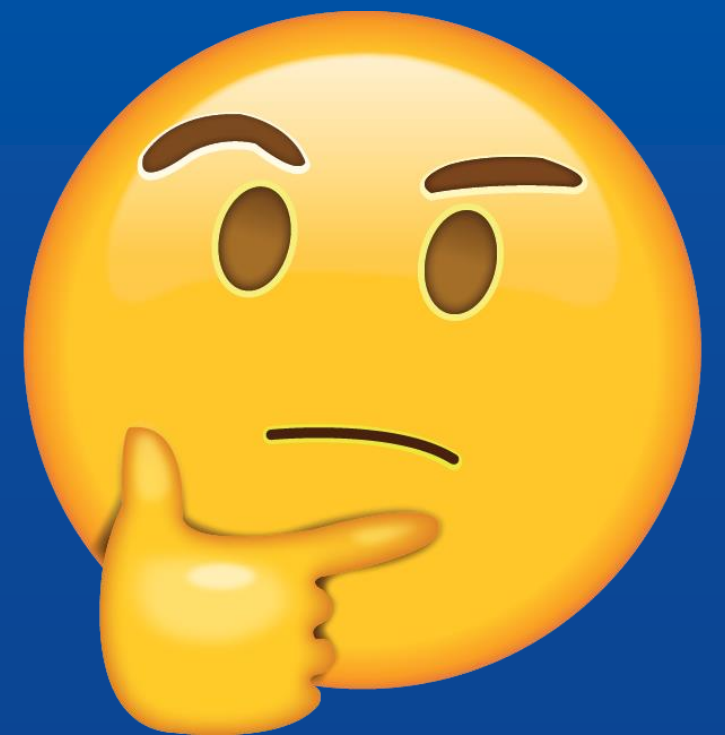
A new revelation for Peter aided by his vision
