


The harbour at Caesarea Maritima. Caesarea was the headquarters for the Roman forces, and Cornelius was stationed there as a centurion (Acts 10:1).



"Do not call anything impure that God has made clean"




How many times does Jesus request something of us and we struggle to respond as it just doesn't seem to fit with our current thinking!




In this passage we see the first explicit conversion and filling of the Holy Spirit amongst the Gentiles.
