1 Thess. 5: 1-11 — ADVENT FUTURE

The Lord's future Appearing – a dominant theme of 1 & 2 Thess.

"You turned to God.... To <u>wait for his Son</u> from heaven....<u>Jesus</u> who delivers us from the <u>coming</u> wrath"

- A source of hope and joyBut also
- Cause for confusion and anxiety

1 Thessalonians 5: 1-11 — Advent Future Hope & Joy//Confusion & Anxiety. Which is it?

Roman and Greek thought

- **ONO sense of hope about the Hereafter**
- Death a tragic loss both to deceased and those left behind

The Christian

- Trust in the Risen Jesus creates eternal relationship surviving death
- * "So we will be with the Lord for ever." 4:17
- "Encourage each other with these words." 4:18
