





While the man held on to Peter and John, all the people were astonished and came running to them in the place called Solomon's Colonnade. When Peter saw this, he said to them: "Fellow Israelites, why does this surprise you? Why do you stare at us as if by our own power or godliness we had made this man walk? (Acts 3:11-12)

And Peter continues, boldly proclaiming the name of Jesus:

By faith in the name of Jesus, this man whom you see and know was made strong. It is Jesus' name and the faith that comes through him that has completely healed him, as you can all see. (3:16)

And in v19, Peter repeats the call that he had made in Acts 2:38 (Repent then and be baptised in the name of Jesus.....):

Repent, then, and turn to God so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the lord (3:19)
