







A French acrobat, Jean François Gravelet, aka “Charles Blondin” crossed the Niagara falls on a tightrope



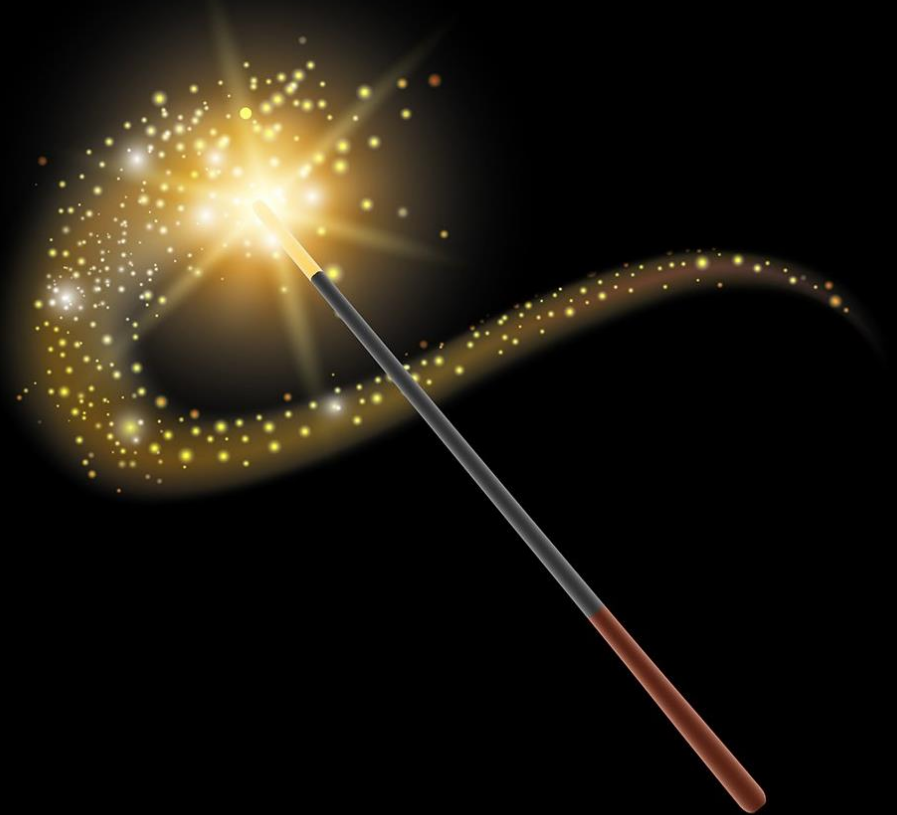
The rope was 335m long and hung 49m above the water
