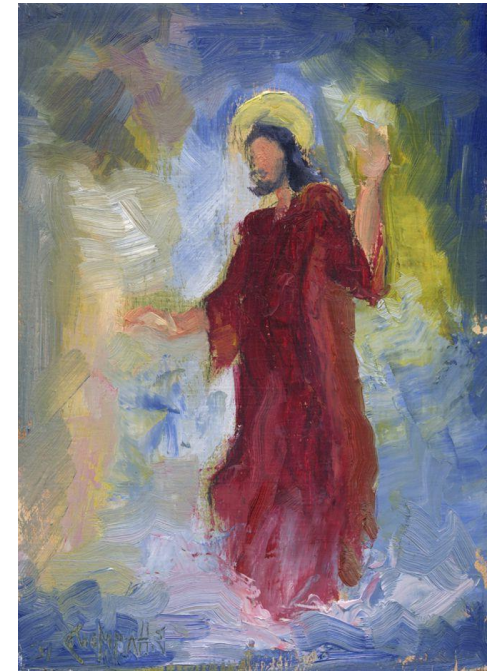
Jesus is Patterned in the Old Testament like a fractal



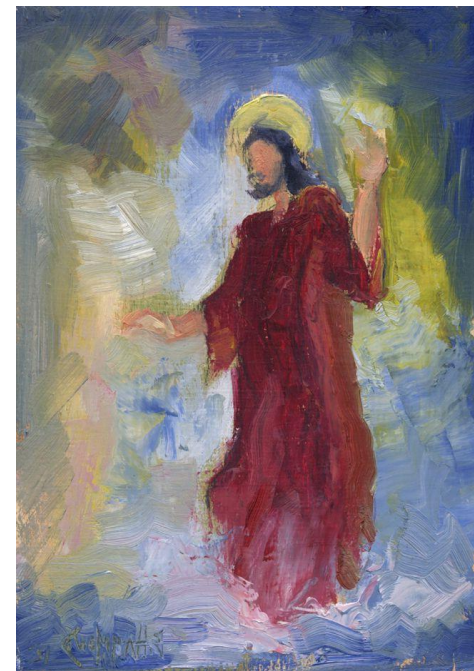
Jesus is Promised in Scripture
