


Jesus' first words are "Peace be with you"






²⁷ And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

Jesus is Patterned in Scripture












Jesus is Patterned in the Old Testament like a fractal





Jesus is Promised in Scripture








Jesus is Present in Scripture







Jesus is Patterned Promised Present












The RESURRECTED CHRIST sends his disciples back into the Word


- What do you find hard / confusing?

- How does knowing the Old Testament is all about Jesus change how we read it?






The RESURRECTED CHRIST sends his disciples out into the World
