Entertaining Jesus out of thankfulness

✤GRATITUDE AND HOW IT SHOWS ITSELF – THE HEART OF THE STORY

- **The Perfume**
- Not one or two drops but a whole bottle!
- Pervasive, Overwhelming Aroma
- Exceptional Devotion
- Exceptional Generosity
- Hugely Sacrificial
