Thomas = "Twin"

One of Apostles - sent out to preach and heal

Witnessed the Lord's Ascension

## John's Gospel - At Lazarus's Illness/Death

"Let us also go, that we may die with him" Jn. 11:16

- Loyalty and Faith in Jesus
- ☐ Courage in face of potential danger
- ☐ Doing the right thing, whatever the consequences

John's Gospel - Jesus's last meal with Disciples

"I am the WAY, the TRUTH, the LIFE" In. 14: 6 Jesus -☐ The living embodiment of God himself ☐ In him we see what God is like ☐ We meet God himself

Why was Thomas absent?

- Disappointment and Grief
- ☐ Personal Remorse and Self Loathing

- >"No way will I believe without evidence" Jn:20:26
- **➣**If only I had reason to believe!

# One week after Resurrection Day Thomas is there.....and Jesus is there!

- ☐ The Command "Stop doubting and believe" 20:27.
- ☐ The Response "My Lord and my God!" 20:28
- \* A direct personal relationship with God himself
- ➤ Christianity's <u>Unique Selling Point</u> [USP]
- Faith/Conviction "proves" the truth of the Resurrection

#### THOMAS - WHAT CAN WE LEARN FROM HIM?

- 1) Honest Doubt and Questioning are OK. Faith is a search for Truth!
- 2) Evidence>>>Conviction of truth>>>Commitment>>>Living Faith
- 3) Christian Fellowship essential to nurturing/sustaining faith

Thomas - not so much doubt and failure Instead - DISCOVERY and RENEWAL!
