- 13 ³ Those who guard their lips preserve their lives, but those who speak rashly will come to ruin.

- 14 ²⁹ Whoever is patient has great understanding, but one who is quick-tempered displays folly.
- 15 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.
- 15 ² The tongue of the wise adorns knowledge, but the mouth of the fool gushes folly.
- 15 ⁴ The soothing tongue is a tree of life, but a perverse tongue crushes the spirit.

- 20³ It is to one's honour to avoid strife, but every fool is quick to quarrel.
- 22²⁴ Do not make friends with a hot-tempered person, do not associate with one easily angered, ²⁵ or you may learn their ways and get yourself ensnared.
- 25 ²⁸ If you cannot control your anger, you are as helpless as a city without walls, open to attack. (GNB)
